Continuing Problems With Parking Fines

Once again, my sincere apologies for the trouble and distress some of you are still experiencing over parking in the car parks of St. Teresa's and St. Joseph's. If you have been issued with fines or letters from Direct Collection Bailiffs, please feel free to bring them to me to deal with.

On Tuesday after the Bank Holiday, I emailed the Civil Enforcement Office with the following:

Dear Sir/Madam, I firstly refer you to my previous email regarding your very many errors in fining people for use of our Church car parks at Teresa's and St. Joseph's in Irlam, Manchester. Unfortunately, your company has delegated Direct Collection Bailiffs Ltd to pursue recovery of monies that are in fact NOT owed by anyone.

This has resulted in great anxiety and annoyance from parishioners and teaching staff at the schools who have received these distressing letters of late. I would request that you contact this company to cancel ALL such letters and acknowledge the terrible mistakes that have been made. If you cannot comply with this request, I will have no option but to instruct the Salford Diocesan Solicitors to represent the parish in bringing to completion the many grievances this is causing to so many people.
